Phase 1: Isolation	<input type="checkbox"/> Enforce absolute cold room structural lockdown. Cease all stock pulling operations. Ensure doors are fully tightly sealed. Affix an emergency placard warning against entry to preserve internal cold reserve pressures.	_____
Phase 2: Metrics	<input type="checkbox"/> Log core digital panel telemetry. Note the exact thermostat temperature display. Review and write down flashing error warnings (e.g., Dixell, Carel panel fault registers) to report to technical support lines.	_____
Phase 3: Diagnostics	<input type="checkbox"/> Check central distribution breakers. Verify plant electrical sub-panels. Identify if main compressors or condenser fan breakers have safely tripped. Do not attempt multiple resets if faults persist.	_____
Phase 4: Transfer	<input type="checkbox"/> Activate secondary stock evacuation lines. If localized plant recovery does not activate within 60 mins, coordinate the transfer of high-value fresh stock categories to backup chest freezers or off-site infrastructure.	_____
