

Walk-In Freezer Door Maintenance Checklist

2. MONTHLY DOOR INSPECTION PARAMETERS

- ☐ **Magnetic Gasket Seal Integrity**
Check gaskets for splits, tears, or localized wear. Ensure a tight, continuous seal around the entire perimeter with no gaps letting in ambient air.
- ☐ **Hinge and Roller Operational Smoothness**
Inspect physical hardware for alignment, tight fittings, and wear. Lubricate moving parts to avoid structural strain during daily high-traffic entries.
- ☐ **Frame Heater Wire Functionality**
Confirm that peripheral heated frame elements are warm to the touch. Active heating is critical to prevent gasket freeze-lock and ice block accumulation.
- ☐ **Safety Release & Interior Latches**
Test panic push-rod release latches and override safety mechanism handles from inside the dark chamber. Verify that personnel cannot be locked inside.
- ☐ **Door Sweep & Threshold Alignment**
Examine the bottom sweep wiper. Ensure it seals cleanly against the floor threshold when fully shut, eliminating thermal draft bypass.
